NOTICE AS TO APPEALS.—Sec. 37 (8) provides:—Any person by whom a proposal is made under this Section, or a person who objects to any such proposal, or the Rating Authority aggrieved by the decision of the Assessment Committee as aforesaid, may appeal against the decision in manner provided by Part II. of the above-named Act, to the Court of Quarter Sessions for the Eastern Division of the County of Suffolk.

Notice of Appeal must be given to the Clerk of the Court to which the Appeal is made before the expiration of twenty-one days after the date on which the above decision was made by the Assessment Committee.

A copy of the notice of appeal must also be served by the appellant within the time allowed for giving notice of the appeal on the Assessment Committee, and on each of the following persons, not being the appellant, that is to say:— (a) the Rating Authority; (b) where the appeal relates to a particular hereditament, the occupier of that hereditament.

The notice of appeal must specify the grounds of appeal.

NOTE.—Any person who does not object to a proposal and/or does not appear before the Assessment Committee in person or by representative to support his objection or proposal has no right of appeal to Quarter Sessions.
