Dear Sirs,

Debenham Sewerage Scheme.

I thank you for your letter of the 3rd instant and the accompanying form of undertaking relating to the drainage of your premises.

It is understood that you intend to connect the domestic sewage from your premises to the sewer, this being the case the undertaking is accepted on the lines discussed with the Council's Chief Sanitary Inspector.

I enclose as requested a form of application for permission to discharge the trade effluent from your premises into the sewer. The application should be completed and returned to me as soon as may be convenient and it will then be considered by the Council whose decision will be notified to you in due course.

Debenham Sewerage Scheme.

In consideration of the Council having agreed at my request and in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Public Health Act, 1936, and the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 1953, to construct and lay a drain (available to serve the property hereinafter mentioned) from the main sewer to the boundary of the public highway I/we

E.W.LIST & SONS

of CHANCERY LANE, DEBENHAM

being the owner(s) of the property known as CHANCERY LANE GARAGE

hereby undertake that I/we will within a period of 12 months after the main sewer past the property has been completed (or after the date when the sewerage system is brought into operation whichever is the later)

- (a) Construct and lay the remaining length or lengths of drain to serve the said property.
- (b) Make all necessary connections to the said drain.
- (c) (If appropriate) Carry out the conversion of the existing closet to a W.C.

I/we further undertake that in default of our carrying out such works in accordance with the foregoing undertaking I/we will on demand made by the Council after the expiration of the said period of one year pay to the Council the actual cost incurred by the Council in the construction of the said length of drain between the main sewer and the boundary of the public highway.
